## Anemo due to play in August

DARLINGS of US College radio, Brighton three-piece Anemo are bringing their brand of modern rock back home with the release of the double A side debut single Made of Fiction and Fallout Renegade on August 14 with the debut album Slowburn following in early

September. Slowburn, released in America last autumn on the New York label City Canyons Records, has already achieved critical acclaim. College radio blasted out album tracks with more than 160 stations picking up the record and returning top 10 chart positions. Their highly polished sound comes from classically trained pianist/keyboardist Kingsley Sage (whose production credits have included Icelandic hipsters Bellatrix) who produces all their music along with Michael Fallon (LeAnn Rimes) Matt Palmer provides the rock/metal

guitars while singer Hazelle Woodhurst's lyrics and vocals fill the spectrum of sound from quiet crystalclear emotions to chaotic hysteria. Made of Fiction is a 4 minute composition that grows from a delicate piano introduction to a passionate rock song. Each instrument adds a subtle layer to the sound which finally erupts into a chorus strong enough to rock any dance floor. Fallout Renegade once again shows song writing and musical arrangement in true ANEMO style as drum loops, distortion and vocal gymnastics dictate how modern rock music should sound. The single also includes an acoustic mix. Anemo are due to play a 30 minute acoustic set as part of Strawberry Jam for the Exmouth Festival at the Manor Gardens on Sunday, August 13. The event starts at 7.30pm.
